MEDICAL SOCIAL WORKS DEPARTMENT

The activities of the MSW Department at MPMMCC & HBCH include:

- In the year 2021-22, the processes and systems at the Medical Social Services department were crystalized.
- Nearly 36,526 patients, frequently approached the Department (MSW), out of which approx.
 11,985 beneficiaries received railway concession.
- Medical Social Workers addressed their psycho social, emotional, and financial needs, by
 advocating, facilitating and being a bridge between the doctor and the patient as well as the care
 givers.
- 656 patients were accommodated at Rain Basera, a free of cost accommodation facility, provided for attendants of Pediatric patients.
- We were fortunate to get funds from Tata Memorial Hospital which empowered us to provide continuous treatment to the underprivileged class of the patients who visited MPMMCC/HBCH.
- Collaboration with ICS-Cancer Cure Fund and V-Care Foundation helped us provide financial assistance to the Cancer patients. New Statutory funding from Rastriya Arogya Nidhi (RAN),
 HMCPF and NHM further strengthened the supply funds whereby we were able to help a considerable number of patients who would have otherwise dropped out of treatment.
- The local stakeholders have proactively participated in the cancer initiatives. **The Rotary club** has donated an electric rickshaw to facilitate travel of the old and needy.
- Department networked with two NGO's, i.e. Varanasi Masonic Lodge Trust & Varanasi Elite
 Round Table, which culminated in a donation for patient care specifically for treatment of COVID
 patients, admitted at HBCH, Varanasi.
- Palliative counselling has commenced and the Medical Social Workers are involved in teleconsultancy for the terminally ill patients.
- Department has also participated in Free COVID vaccination drive organized by HBCH/MPMMCC and ALKEM, for local resident (boatman, vendors, hawkers) at Subah-e-Banaras Assi Ghat, Varanasi.
- Medical Social Service department organizes many recreational activities on the occasion of festivals like Dussehra and Diwali to bring happiness to patients and caregivers.
- Coordination with the officials of Patna Secretariat to streamline and Expedite the process of Bihar
 Chief Minister Relief Fund.
