**INDEMNITY BOND**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT on this day of \_\_\_\_\_ Year

(hereinafter called collectively as "Sureties" other part,

Hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves and our respective heirs executors and administrators to pay to Tata Memorial Centre (hereinafter referred as the 'TMC', its successors and assignees, on demand the sum of Rs.6,00,000 (Rupees Six Lakhs)/5,00,000 (Rupees Five Lakhs) with penal interest + applicable GST as the case may be and as hereinafter contained together with interest thereon from the date of demand till the date of payment or will be ineligible for the award of PG degree in the event of breach of the conditions by the said PG student as out below.

2.0) WHEREAS, the PG student has applied to the Centre against open advertisement for admission to the PG degree in Occupational Therapy course conducted by the Tata Memorial Centre for imparting training in Master of Occupational Therapy In Therapy degree (hereinafter referred to as PG course).

Now the conditions to be observed and complied with by the said PG student and their sureties are as under :

- a) The PG student has voluntarily accepted admission to the PG course for the period from \_\_\_\_\_ (2 years with one year bond). The PG student has clearly understood that he/she will be required to sign a bond for completion of the residency tenure for the period of 1 year and binds himself/herself that he/she will complete the course, failing which he/she would be bound to pay sum of Rs.5,00,000 (Rupees Five Lakhs) with penal interest + applicable GST or

will be ineligible for the award of PG degree to the Tata Memorial Centre forthwith on demand by the Tata Memorial Centre together with the interest there on from the date of default, at the rate prescribed of Government loans and prevailing on the date of demand or if payment is made in the country other than India, the equivalent amount of the currency of that country converted at the official rate of exchange between that country and India. This condition shall however, not be applicable to the candidate who is resigning before the final round of selection conducted by the Tata Memorial Centre on prescribed dates decided by these Authorities.

- b) The PG student clearly understand that in the event the said PG student continue the course for the entire duration of 2 years and on his/her successful completion he/she is required to serve for a minimum period of one year the Tata Memorial Centre, including the Tata Memorial Centers, located in the urban and non urban areas (such as HBCHRC, Sangrur, Mullanpur / HBCHRC, Vizag / HBCH, Varanasi / MPMMCC, Varanasi / BKLWHDRC, Dervan / Aurangabad / BCCI, Guwahati / CCE, Mumbai / HBCHRC, Muzaffarpur / CCHRC Silchar and any other areas) and he/she will be paid consolidated stipend as may be prescribe at that point of time and in any case it will not be less than the consolidated stipend paid him/her on the date of qualifying in the said degree. The PG student further binds himself/herself along with the sureties that in the event he/she fails to serve as stated herein before at the Tata Memorial Centre and the mentioned outreach station, unit as aforesaid for the said minimum period of one year, he/she will be liable to pay the sum of Rs.6,00,000 (Rupees Six Lakhs) with penal interest + applicable GST or will be ineligible for the award of PG degree as a breach of condition. Student will not be allowed to leave during Service Bond period for any reason (job opportunity or for further studies). Student under Bond cannot apply for any Post/ any other course/ P.G. studies/ Scholarship or appear for any Examination or Interview outside. Students on Bond if selected, for State or Central Govt. service or Private sector service then they have to take permission for joining period after completion of bond.

3.0) The sureties viz (i) \_\_\_\_\_ (ii) \_\_\_\_\_ do hereby jointly and severally covenant with the Centre that if the said PG student make default in payment of the sum of Rs.6,00,000 (Rupees Six Lakhs) with penal interest + applicable GST or will be ineligible for the award of PG degree as mentioned above or any part thereof, together with interest there on from the date of demand at Government rates for the time being in force on Government loans, the sureties shall on demand and without murmur pay to the Centre the said sum of Rs.6,00,000 (Rupees Six Lakhs) with penal interest + applicable GST or will be ineligible for the award of PG degree together with interest thereon from the date of default at the rate levied for Government loan and prevailing on the date of demand and that the liability of sureties hereunder shall not in any way be affected by any time waiver or indulgence of any nature of any kind whatsoever given made or shown by the Centre to or in favor of the said PG students. The sureties hereby agree that to all intents and purposes the liability of the sureties for the payment of all the sum of money under this agreement shall be deemed to be that of the principal parties each of both the sureties, jointly and severally.

4.0) Notwithstanding anything herein contained, it shall be lawful for the Centre to terminate the tenure of the Residency of the course, if his/her progress has been found to be Unsatisfactory by the Centre or any violations of the rules/regulations, as applicable or for the other reason of which the Centre shall be sole judge, and in that event the said amount of Rs.6,00,000 (Rupees Six Lakhs) with penal interest + applicable GST or will be ineligible for the award of PG degree as contained in Para 3 above shall become payable by said PG students/ Sureties immediately and the said PG student shall be bound to pay the same and if he/she falls to do so, the sureties shall be jointly and responsible to pay the same to the centre on demand.

5.0) It is expressly understood by the said PG Students and the sureties herein that the TMC shall be entitled to recover the said sum of Rs.6,00,000 (Rupees Six Lakhs)/ Rs.5,00,000 (Rupees Five Lakhs) with penal interest + applicable GST as the case may be in the event of default of their payment on demand or will be ineligible for the award of PG degree and that TMC shall be entitled to initiate civil/criminal proceedings as may be required at the cost, risk and consequences of the said PG student and the sureties thereon. This agreement in all respects be governed by the laws of India for the time being in force and the courts in Mumbai shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try the dispute and adjudicate between the parties.
