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

Homi Bhabha National Institute, (BARC), Mumbai - Recognition of M.Ch.(Surgical Oncology) qualification against increased intake from 02(Two) to 16(Sixteen) seat(s) in respect of students being trained at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai.

Sir,

It is stated that the assessment report (June, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai for purpose of Recognition of M.Ch.(Surgical Oncology) qualification against increased intake from 02(Two) to 16(Sixteen) seat(s) granted by Homi Bhabha National Institute, (BARC), Mumbai was considered by the Board of Governors and it was decided as under:-

"The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (June, 2013) and noted that M.Ch.(Surgical Oncology) qualification is already recognized with 02(Two) seat(s) and decided to recommend that M.Ch.(Surgical Oncology) qualification against increased intake from 02(Two) to 16(Sixteen) seat(s) granted by Homi Bhabha National Institute, (BARC), Mumbai in respect of students being trained at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 16(Sixteen) student(s) per year."

The Board of Governors further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 6.4 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-cluase-4 shall invariably 6.6 result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.
