## Observership Program in Gynecological Oncology

Department	:	Gynecological Oncology under Department of Surgical
Duration	:	1 to 6 Month
Eligibility	:	MS/MD/DNB Ob-Gyn

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### Goals of Observership:

This program is devised with the following goals –

1. To learn how to approach to a patient with Gynaecological cancer.
2. To understand management protocols for common Gynaecological cancers.
3. To acquire a thorough knowledge of pelvic and retroperitoneal anatomy and to learn basic principles on Onco-surgery.
4. To acquire basic knowledge of chemotherapy, radiation therapy and palliative care related to gynaecological oncology.
5. To learn about preventive aspects of Gynec Oncology including management of pre-invasive diseases.

### Experience during Observership:

#### I. CLINICAL

##### OUT PATIENT CLINIC

- In the first Four weeks: To learn outpatient work-up; history taking, clinical examination, pre-treatment investigations and follow up protocols.
- Actively involved in Gynaecologic Oncology MDTs (Multidisciplinary Team) meetings
- Learn
  - 1) Disease staging
  - 2) To read CT scan/MRI
  - 3) Basic histopathology and cytology
  - 4) Treatment decision making
  - 5) Post-treatment rehabilitation protocols

##### INPATIENT:



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- Daily Ward rounds along with residents and consultants
- Learn
  - 1) Post-operative management of cases like radical cytoreductive surgeries, Radical Hysterectomy
  - 2) Post-operative case in stoma patients, Patients having resection and anastomosis
  - 3) Treatment decision for surgical intervention in palliative patients, like sub acute intestinal obstruction, obstructive uropathies

#### **SURGICAL EXPOSURE**

##### **Learning Objectives:**

- a. To assist and perform the following surgeries
  - Staging Lapartomy for Endometrial Cancer
  - Staging Laparotomy for early ovarian cancer
  - Interval debulking surgery for ovarian cancer
- b. To assist in following surgeries
  - To assist upfront surgery for advanced ovarian cancer
  - To assist radical hysterectomy + pelvic lymphadenectomy
  - To assist Retroperitoneal lymphadenectomy
  - To assist vulvectomy
  - To assist groin node dissection
  - To assist in bowel mobilization, basic principles of bowel injury repair, Resection and anastomosis and making stoma
  - To assist in bladder injury repair
  - To assist in Ovarian Transposition
  - To assist in minimal access surgery
- c. Minor OT Procedures
  - Diagnostic hysteroscopy
  - Colposcopy1
  - LEEP
