**Qualification :**

**Post Graduation in Science (M. Pharm, Life Sciences, Biotech, Zoology, Botany etc.) with Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Research is mandatory.**

**Experience :**

**Minimum 1year of experience** in monitoring of interventional clinical trials (RCTs) in allopathy is **mandatory**. Experience in Oncology clinical trials will be preferred. Candidate with monitoring experience during training can also apply.

Candidate should have good communication skills, both verbal and written and should be fluent in English Language.

**Remuneration** :Between Rs.23000/- p.m. & Rs.60000/- p.m.

The salary will commensurate with experience and qualifications of the candidate.
