



Tata Memorial Centre announces “**4th Summer School Programme in oncology**” in partnership with **King’s College London** in association with **Tata Trusts** to be conducted in May 2018 in Mumbai.

Tata Memorial Centre has a thriving academic partnership in cancer research and training with King’s College London, a leading global university.

The module is titled “**Fundamentals in Oncology (FinO)**” and applications are invited from:

- MBBS (Final) Part 1 Students.
- Post Graduate Students – those who have completed 1st year in General Medicine, General Surgery, Orthopedics, ENT, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Paediatric.

The aim of the course is to enhance the knowledge, skills and aptitude of medical graduates regarding cancer, to better serve society’s needs. The course will give an overview of cancer management and enable participants to realize their aptitude and future career in oncology. The faculty will be drawn from both King’s College London and the Tata Memorial Centre.

Dates: The summer school module will run from May 7th May to 18th May and will be conducted at the Tata Memorial Centre campus. Last Date of registration is 30th April, 2018.

Seats: The participation is limited to 150 students overall (Out of which 30 from North East) and selection will be based on the depth and quality of their Statement of Purpose.

Award:

1. Successful participants will receive a certificate, awarded jointly by Tata Memorial Centre and King’s College London.
2. During the foundations of oncology course, the students will be evaluated by written test followed by interview. Overall performance during the session’s will also be considered for evaluation.
3. **The top 5 Meritorious students selected will get the opportunity to undergo their 1 week clinical observers at Tata Memorial Centre & 4 weeks Clinical Observer ship at Guy’s Cancer Hospital and St. Thomas hospital, London at no cost to them.**

Fees: True to the principles of the Tata Memorial Centre, the course fees of Rs 25000 will be covered by Tata Trusts. Arrangements will be made for shared accommodation and local transportation (within Mumbai) for students traveling from outside Mumbai.
