Entrance exam	 There will be MCQ (100 marks) to be completed in 100 minutes, Group discussion (30 marks) to be completed in 30 minutes and VIVA 20 marks. Total marks 150. Candidates who are amongst the top – three times the number of seats available (minimum 50% marks) in the MCQ & Group discussion will be called for the Viva. Final merit list will be based on the total scores obtained out of maximum of 150 marks which will be derived by adding 130 marks (MCQ & Group discussion) and 20 marks (Viva) Topics wise marks: Oncology Nursing – 30 marks, General Nursing– 20 marks, General English –15 marks, Maths – 15 marks and General knowledge – 20 marks. There will be minimum of Five Examiners out of which one will be an External Examiner.
