(i)	This environmental clearance will be valid for a period of seven years from the date of its issue or till the completion of the project, whichever is earlier.	Agreed
(ii)	Any appeal against this environmental clearance shall lie with the National Green Tribunal, if preferred, within a period of 30 days as prescribed under Section 16 of the National Green Tribunal ACT, 2010	Agreed
(iii)	A first aid room will be provided in the project both during construction and operation phase of the project.	We have already provided the firstaid room at the project area during the construction phase.
(iv)	Construction of the STP, solid waste, e-waste, hazardous waste, storage facilities tubewell, DG Sets, Utilities etc, earmarked by the project proponent on the layout plan, should be made in the earmarked area only. In any case the position/location of these utilities should not be changed later-on.	Agreed
(v)	The environmental safeguards contained in the application of the promoter / mentioned during the presentation before State Level Environment impact Assessment Authority/State Expert Appraisal Committee should be implemented in letter and spirit.	Agreed
(vi)	Ambient air & noise levels should confirm to prescribed standards both during day and night. Incremental pollution loads on the ambient air quality, noise especially during worst noise generating activities, water quality and soil should be periodically monitored during construction phase as well as operation & entire life	The Ambient Air Quality, Noise Level , Water and Soil quality will be monitored regularly and the report will be attached as <b>Annexure-I</b>
