Selection Criteria	Selection will be based on the evaluation of performance of MCQ exam physically conducted at TMH, followed by VIVA on the same day. A fixed number of candidates (not exceeding 3 times the number of seats) will be called for the VIVA.

1. Security/ Caution Deposit: - Rs. 1,33,620/-

A Security / Caution Deposit is to be paid at the time of joining. The deposit will be refunded without interest after successful completion of the fellowship course.

- If a candidate leaves the fellowship in between without intimation, his/her last month's salary (30 days) will be forfeited.
- If a candidate leaves before completing the fellowship, the entire deposit will be forfeited.

2. Appointed candidates may be posted based on the requirements of the departments at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai, Advanced Centre for Treatment, Research and Education in Cancer at Kharghar, Navi Mumbai, or any of the non-Mumbai units of TMC (Sangrur, New Chandigarh-Punjab, Varanasi, Visakhapatnam, Muzaffarpur, Guwahati).

3. Candidate may be provided shared accommodation, subject to availability. Hostel Charges will be deducted monthly from the salary.

4. All PG & Super-Specialty degrees must be recognized by the National Medical Commission. It is mandatory for all candidates selected and appointed in TMH to be registered with the Maharashtra Medical Council.

5. If the candidate is currently employed in a government or related organization (Central / State Government / Autonomous Body / Semi-Government Organization), he/she must obtain a No Objection Certificate from their current employer. The NOC should be issued through the Head of his/her Institution/Department. The candidate must upload the NOC as part of the application process. Additionally, he/she must bring the original NOC document when appearing for the MCQ Test or VIVA; failing to produce it, the candidate will not be being allowed to appear for the MCQ/VIVA.
6. Candidates shall pay the online application fee of Rs.1000/- by using Debit / Credit Card or UPI. The application fee, once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. Candidates must ensure that they fulfill the eligibility criteria before applying for the post and making payment. Any duplicate payment made towards the application form fee will not be refunded.
7. The Online application form must be filled out completely in all respects. Incomplete applications will be rejected. No other mode of application will be accepted.
8. The last date for submission of the online application is 02.06.2026 up to 05.00 p.m. (Indian Standard Time). Candidates are advised to submit their applications well in advance without waiting for the closing date. Candidates are "NOT" required to submit or send a hard copy of the application form.
9. Candidates must submit documentary evidence in support of the details furnished in the online application form, including proof of date of birth, qualifications, experience, medical registration certificate, caste, disability certificate, NOC etc., failing to provide such documents will be treated as incomplete and summarily rejected.
10. Tata Memorial Centre reserves the right to cancel the posts, fix minimum eligibility standards / benchmarks and restrict the number of candidates called for the MCQ/Viva taking into account factors such as the number of vacancies and candidates performance. The Centre also reserves the right to determine the qualifying marks for selecting candidates for the Viva. Merely fulfilling the prescribed qualifications will not entitle an applicant to be called for the MCQ/VIVA. Further the Centre may fix minimum eligibility standards or cut-off marks (Group/Stream/Discipline/Category-wise etc.) for shortlisting candidates for VIVA and for final selection after the Viva. The decision of the Director of the Tata Memorial Centre in this regards shall be final and no representation will be entertained in this regard.
11. All correspondence with applicants via the e-mail ID **training-acad.tmh@tmc.gov.in**. The Centre will not be responsible for non-receipt of application due to online submission errors, incorrect e-mail IDs provided by candidates or e-mails being delivered to spam/bulk folders. All applicants must provide their latest mobile number and a valid e-mail ID to ensure timely communication.
12. No TA/DA (Travel Allowance / Dearness Allowance) will be admissible for candidates appearing for the MCQ/VIVA.
13. Application will be rejected if a candidate provides incorrect or false information in the application form. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

**MCQ/VIVA:** The names of the shortlisted candidates for the MCQ/ VIVA will be uploaded on the official website of Tata Memorial Centre (<https://tmc.gov.in> → Training Program). Candidates are advised to check the website frequently for updates and information related to the MCQ/VIVA.
